Job Purpose

The International Consultant/Research Advisor will support ARMAC team to oversee and co-manage the research studies in Lao PDR and Viet Nam. He/she will provide technical advice and guidance to the research team leaders which may include but not limited to the research design and on-going implementation. The Consultant/Advisor is also expecting to assist the research teams' country with problem-solving, and to ensure that the research is conducted in line with the research aims and objectives. In addition, he/she will provide support on the finalization of each country's research study and consolidate them to produce a final report in English language.

Key Tasks and Responsibilities

The consultant/research advisor will:

- Oversee and co-manage on the implementation of the studies in Lao PDR and Viet Nam;
- Provide advisory support to the research team leaders in the development of the research plan, research tools, the choice of study location, the sampling methodology and choice of key informants;
- Join regular meetings (remotely) with the research team leaders and ARMAC to discuss the research progress and to solve any issues occurring;
- Hold regular meetings with the team leaders to discuss emerging findings and to suggest areas of inquiry as they arise;
- Review and discuss the main findings and recommendations with the team leaders;
- Work with the team leaders to finalize the studies in each country and synthesize them to produce a single report in English;
- Ensure the final product of the research study is edited; and
- Other relevant duties as may be assigned from time to time.
